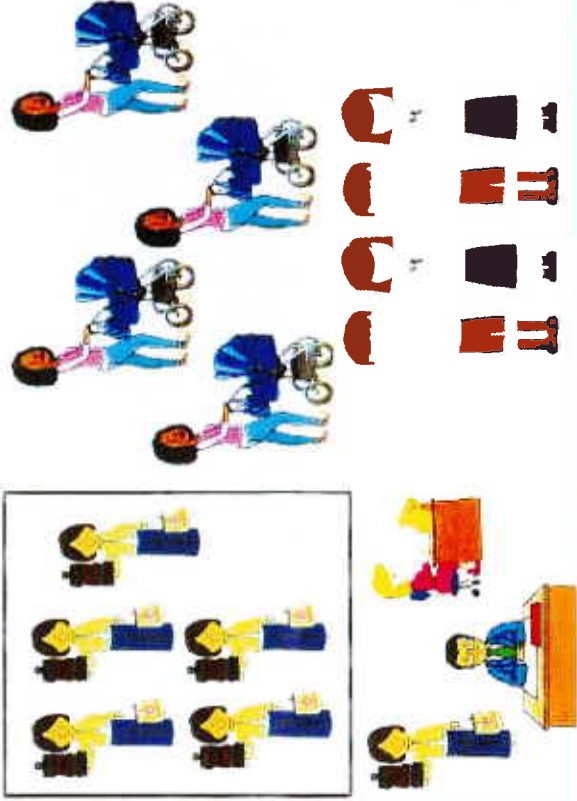


# Composition of Councils

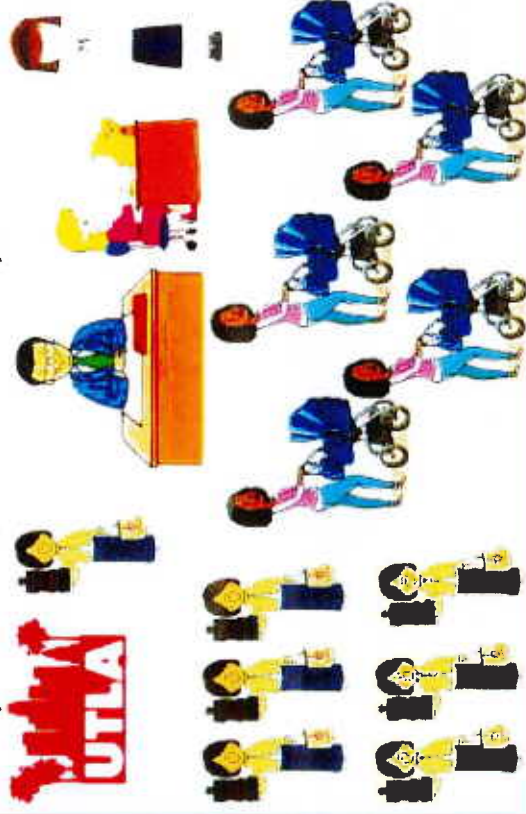
## SSC

- At least 16 members
- Half: School staff (teachers, principal, classified) - *majority must be classroom teachers (50% of day in class)!*
- Half: Parents/community members + students (equal parts)



## LSLC

- 16 members
- UTLA Chapter Chair and principal are co-chairs
- 50% = UTLA CC + certificated
- 50% = principal, classified, parents/community, student

Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50% = UTLA CC + certificated employees</li> <li>• 50% = principal + parent/community rep(s) + non-certificated staff member + student rep (secondary only)</li> <li>• <i>All positions elected annually unless the school's by-laws allow for staggered two-year terms (See Article XXVII 2.8, e.)</i></li> <li>• <i>Parents who are District employees MAY serve on LSLC in a "Parent" position.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50% staff (including principal, teachers, and other school personnel)</li> <li>• 50% parents, guardians, community members, and students (secondary only) – equal parts students and parents/community</li> <li>• <i>The majority of UTLA members must be role-carrying classroom teachers for at least HALF of their workday.</i></li> <li>• <i>All positions elected annually</i></li> <li>• <i>Parents who are District employees MAY serve in a "Staff" position, but MAY NOT serve in a "Parent" position.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Department Chairs</li> <li>• Administration</li> <li>• Coordinators</li> <li>• Instructional Leaders, such as librarian, coaches, etc</li> </ul>
Size	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ High schools and middle schools have 16 members (8 certificated, 5 community, classified, student, principal).</li> <li>▪ Special cases: SMALL schools (6 or fewer teachers) have 6 members on LSLC. Schools with 7 - 15 teachers have 8 members, and secondary schools with 16-25 teachers have 12 members on LSLC.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Elementary schools must have at least 10 members, but they can also choose to have a 12-, 16-, or 20-member council.</li> <li>▪ Secondary schools must have at least 12 members, but they can also choose to have a 16- or 20-member council.</li> <li>▪ Middle schools can choose whether or not to include students, but high schools MUST have them. If a school chooses NOT to have a student rep, the council must vote.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Varies</li> </ul>
Leaders	UTLA rep and principal are the co-chairs.	The council elects a chair, co-chair, and secretary during the orientation and election meeting at the beginning of each school year.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rotates, depending on purpose</li> </ul>
Time	Up to 10 meetings, two hours each or equivalent	At least 6 meetings per year, not counting mandatory orientation and election meeting.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least 6 meetings per year, prior to PD Tuesdays</li> </ul>
