A Note from the Principal

Important things to remember during arrival and dismissal

- If you are picking up in the front carline, you must stay in your car. This is a loading zone.
- Move your car forward when prompted by the adults. Do not stop to pick your child up if there is room in front of you to move forward.
- Students are not allowed to cross the crosswalk in the parking lot without an adult.
- Use the crosswalk at the front of the school. This is the only crosswalk in the parking lot so it is important to model for our students how to stay safe and follow traffic laws.
- If you would like to meet your child at their dismissal site, park your car in the lot.
- Please obey traffic rules and signs. This includes parking in the handicap spots without the proper identification, parking in drop off zones, not using crosswalks, not parking in front of someone's driveway, etc.
- Be kind and patient. We are all working hard to ensure your child's safety.
